



Iodine Detergent Udder Wash

Features and Benefits

- ★ Concentrated formula reduces gallons needed per year and cost per use.
- ★ The germicidal power of iodine helps lower bacteria numbers on teats prior to machine attachment, helping to improve milk quality.
- ★ Excellent detergent qualities aid milkers in quickly removing soils from teats, reducing cow preparation time while improving teat cleanliness.
- ★ Deep brown color serves as an excellent indicator of udder wash solution strength.
- ★ Mild pH formula is gentle to teat skin when diluted following label directions.

Iodine Detergent Udder Wash is a 1.75% high detergency iodine product that can be used for udder wash.

Directions for Use

Udder Washing

Following the table of proportions, prepare a fresh solution with the iodine level desired. Wash teats with solution using a clean single-service towel. Dry teats with a separate towel for each cow prior to machine attachment.

A fresh solution of udder wash should be prepared if amber-to-brown color significantly lightens.

Udder Washing

12.5 ppm – 1 oz. in 10 gallons water

25 ppm – 1 oz. in 5 gallons water

50 ppm – 1 oz. in 2.5 gallons water

If frozen, thaw completely and mix well before using.

DO NOT USE AS A TEAT DIP.
